



We are so excited about Small Business Saturday as we head into the Christmas shopping season. We promote our downtown and small businesses all year long, but at this time of year, it is especially important to remember our small locally owned retail businesses. Ashland is very fortunate to have 95% of our small retail businesses locally owned and operated. Ashland is full of unique, locally owned businesses that support Ashland sports teams, charities, and community events. This is the time of year when purchases by community members show those business owners how much we appreciate their support! To give added incentive to consumers, for every \$10 (ten dollars) you spend at a small locally owned retail business through the end of the year...you can receive one entry into the Shop Small Win Big Raffle. The prizes are **two drawings of \$250.00 in Chamber Dollars**. The first deadline for entries is Monday, November 28th, with the drawing on Wednesday, November 30th following Small Business Saturday. On **Small Business Saturday, November 26th**, you will **receive double** entries. Your entries from the first drawing will stay in the basket throughout the raffle period. (November 18th – December 31st). The second drawing will be held on January 6th, 2017.

Entry into the Shop Small Big Win Raffle is easier than ever! All receipts (or copies of the receipts) from downtown and Ashland small locally owned retail businesses, can be stapled to one entry form and dropped off or mailed to the Ashland Chamber Office at PO Box 746 – Or, you can drop off your entry forms at the reception desk at Northern State Bank on Main Street. The total dollar value will be used to determine the number of times the individual is entered into the raffle. Shoppers can even include receipts from purchasing gift certificates from locally owned retail businesses! Full contest details and printable raffle entry forms are also available at locally owned small business retailers throughout downtown and Ashland and on our website www.visitashland.com.




