Ashland Area Chamber of Commerce announces the **2018 Ashland Retail Storefront Business Contest**. The "*Opportunity Knocks*" *contest* is designed to encourage entrepreneurs to submit their *retail business* concept for consideration and to open a storefront on Ashland's Historic Main Street, between the 200 and 500 blocks of Main Street West. (Existing locations of available storefronts). Our goal is to assist with the opening of at least one new retail business located in the Historic downtown area of 200 to 500 Main Street West. The contest is open to new retail businesses and includes food /eateries. We are focused on occupying available retail space with businesses that <u>complement existing</u> businesses.

The Grand Prize Winner will receive:

- \$2,500 in cash with a signed 36 month lease agreement or accepted offer to purchase a storefront within the geographical boundary.
- Free advertising package with the Ashland Daily Press & the Evergreen Country Shopper.
- Free advertising package with Heartland Communications.
- 12 hours of free accounting and consulting services with Maitland, Singler & Van Vlack.
- Start-up business \$3,000 loan (1% interest/3 year) from the Ashland Area Chamber of Commerce downtown development revolving loan fund.

- Exposure to various media outlets during the announcement of the winning submittals.
- 10 \$25 Chamber Dollar Gift Certificates for promotional give-aways during business grand-opening. \$250 total.

Additionally, we'll be creating a Waterfalls brochure with the numerous waterfalls in Ashland, Bayfield, and Iron Counties. Waterfalls are a very trendy and remain a popular pastime.

In 2018, Ashland will celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Ashland Mural Walk. Look for new activities and entertainment at the annual Mural Fest and Car Show in September. Our countywide promotions will include updating our county mural booklet and adding the new murals on Madeline Island and Marengo to the existing "Follow the Mural Brick Road" booklet.



Also, during the first quarter of 2018 we have partnered with Bayfield County Tourism and have created a silent sports winter trails booklet. The idea is to promote the vast number of silent sport trails and opportunities *and* to get off the couch and into the outdoors! We were awarded \$10,000 in marketing dollars from the State of Wisconsin Department of Tourism to assist with this promotion
