SNOWMOBILE INFORMATION



Effective July 1, 2015, Wisconsin snowmobile registration will cost \$30.00 for three years. In addition, all snowmobiles will be required to have an annual trail pass to operate on a public trail or corridor. Trail passes will cost non-club/non-Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs members \$30.00 and can only be purchased through the DNR. Members who belong to both a snowmobile club and the AWSC will be able to buy the trail pass for \$10.00.
