Happy Independence Day!

The 4th of July historically marks the start of our tourism season. We have been very busy with travelers this June along with construction teams and conferences. I love the events that take place in Ashland over the 4th of July. The parade is a favorite among many as well as the ever popular fire-run!! Mark Drolson with Celebrations, Incorporated has been busy selling firework raffle tickets and we thank him for his efforts to continue to bring us a spectacular show! This year the firework show will take place off of the oredock! The parade will take place on the 4th at 11am starting at the corner of 8th and Main Street.

Speaking of traditions, I did want to take this opportunity to explain the reason that our "Events and Promotions Committee" chose to change Maxwell Street Days to a new date and give it a new name. For many years the discussion has taken place, after the event, about the success or non-success of the event; and each year there is more negative feedback from the community about Maxwell Street Days. Back in the day, when there was no internet or commerce, aside from Main Street, the streets were full of businesses that would move out their old merchandise. Today we don't have the businesses who were at one time the anchors of Maxwell Street Days like JC Penney and maurices. Our small retailers only have a short window to sell their new merchandise and move their new inventory. Vendors that sell Arts & Crafts weren't as successful as in the past, so they chose other festivals to attend. Therefore this year we chose to change the event to a new name and schedule it on a new date a little later in the summer, August 4 and 5. This will no longer compete with the Duluth sidewalk sales in July, and we are scheduling our Downtown Days on the same time frame as the Chequamegon Food CO-OP's annual block party, the Farmer's Market, and the east end businesses are hosting a Music & Arts Festival that same Saturday, August 5. Friday will be the day that you will find the popular Northern State Bank Hospice Sale and Northlakes Community Clinic will also have an all staff Rummage Sale. The City of Ashland will be doing a fund-raiser for the K-9 Unit, and we will see sidewalk sales from the existing businesses from Home Expressions to New England Store. Music, Food, and Fun! August 4th and August 5th look for the new Downtown Days hosted by the Ashland Area Chamber of Commerce and area retailers. As always, thank you for shopping local!

As I write this, I am pleased to say we have completed three major events already since May. The Chequamegon Bay Birding & Nature Festival, Apostle Islands Inline Marathon, and Superior Vistas Bicycle Tour! All three are great for the area and we see people from all over the United States participating in these events.

Bay Days is right around the corner. We have an incredibly full calendar of music, fun, attractions, and lots of things for kids to do, so bring the family.
