

There is a full schedule of 4th of July activities in the area and in the whole county for that matter! From the traditional 4th of July shin-dig on Madeline Island all the way to the southern border in Butternut, you can find all sorts of "goings-on" in the county! The 4th of July parade entries are coming in strong, and we are hopeful that we will be able to offer another outstanding line-up of community residents, organizations, schools, and businesses marching down Main Street. The Parade starts at 11am at the Deep Water Grille and moves all the way to Stuntz Avenue. For the safety of our spectators, we will be routing traffic OFF of Main Street West *after* the parade. So please plan on using Highway 2 or 3rd Street. We have seen some near misses in the past, and want to make sure pedestrians have ample time to pack up and head back to their vehicles.

We are off to a healthy tourist season! The Bird and Nature Festival, and the Apostle Islands Inline Marathon were huge successes and participation increased in both events! There are LOTS of travelers in town and although we had to weather the last storm, people are still moving from point A to point B. 
CHAMBER NEWS
