We are off and running for the season with our jam-packed event and promotion schedule!

The Chequamegon Bay Birding and Nature Festival was a huge success with nearly 400 participants traveling from all over the Midwest to enjoy the spring migration. Fortunately, the festival starts on Thursday and runs through Saturday, so they missed the snow event on Sunday!! Two rare bird sightings took place which made the event even more spectacular. A Hooded Oriole and an Audubon Warbler. Two very rare birds indeed! Thank you to our committee and all of the friendly, knowledgeable trip leaders that took the time to make this a great event!

The Wine Walk also took place on the same Thursday of the festival and we had about 80 participants downtown shopping and sampling in our stores. It was very, very busy and the ladies & men had a great time!!

Saturday, was the annual House - to - House Garage Sale and there were 49 garage sales that persevered through the crisp, windy, wet day – Lots of bargains were found!! Thank you to the Daily Press for partnering with us on that event.

The Ashland Area Chamber of Commerce Annual Dinner was Thursday, May 30th where we honored our 2019 Person of the Year, Mari Kay-Nabozny.

In just a few weeks, we will head over to the island for the annual Apostle Islands Inline Marathon. People from all over the country will be here to compete in this popular, fun, high-powered event! The Elite skaters can travel up to 28 mph on rollerblades! It's fast and furious and fun to watch. The skaters absolutely love the smooth blacktop on the island!! They start in Ashland, with registration and packet pickup on Friday and the race starts on the island at 8:30am on Saturday, June 15th. Immediately after the inline, we head to West End Park for the annual Superior Vistas Bike Tour. Last year we had to cancel the event because of the flooding, but we are back and in full swing! 4th of July is on Thursday this year, so many folks will come in for a long weekend to visit friends and family and we know in advance, that we will have a fabulous parade!!
