



Greetings! from Mary McPhetridge, Executive Director

January & February in chamber, tourism world is clean up, catch up, analyze, and budget time!! The Ashland area was a bit inundated with all sorts of unusual weather patterns in 2019, but in spite of those obstacles, we enjoyed a strong year in tourism. The Cobblestone Inn & Suites added 51 new rooms to the mix of inventory. Best Western/Hotel Chequamegon underwent a large renovation project and the restaurant & bar area is the fruit of that hard work! The lake views are even more spectacular with the new large windows and open concept! Many of our properties like the Bayview Motel, underwent soft and hard good changes and the Blue Wave Inn landed a new management agreement and increased their occupancy exponentially! At a recent hotel tourism meeting we talked about the great mix of lodging options available in Ashland. Ashland is very diverse in our economic business markets from Manufacturing to Education to Medical and everything in between, and it is the same with our lodging. Chains, Independents, Inns, Cabins, Mom & Pop "drive up", and Boutique hotels all make Ashland a fabulous destination, not to mention the beautiful back drop of the bay and a thriving downtown that offers locals and tourists alike an opportunity to eat and shop on Main Street!!

We will also be placing billboard messages in the Duluth market to create awareness to travelers that may not realize there is a piece of heaven just up the road!! They tend to land in Canal Park and that becomes their final destination. We are also embarking on a mission to find the "Inline Skaters" in the country that don't know about the race we coordinate

in June on Madeline Island. We hold our registration and packet pick up in Ashland and people tend to stay and play all over the area for that event, but we need to find more skaters. We will use a method known as Geo-Fencing to target inline skating events and shopping behaviors to find the skaters and then hit them with the Apostle Islands Inline video and messaging!! Our new 2020 Visitor & Activity guide for Ashland County is a hit!! Take a look at the cover! It is St. Peter's Dome and is absolutely, breathtakingly, beautiful! We are so blessed to live in a place that offers such picturesque beauty and the charm of our businesses and locals that receive great reviews on Friendliness!!

The next big event for the area is Book Across the Bay and race director, Ben Thoen, says, conditions are excellent this year. Look for 3000 participants in the area on Saturday, February 15th and thank you in advance to all who are volunteering!
