I'm going to start with some great news for our downtown! Dominoes IS open and fully staffed! There has been an accepted on the former Johnson Flower Shop & Ashland Museum building (509-511 Main Street). Play Unplugged will be moving into their new location this week! They are moving from the 200 block of Main Street into the former Crossroads /Hallmark building which is bigger and can accommodate their space needs! Sutherland CBD is doing well in the former Music Center building. Downtown has been busy, and we have sold an enormous amount of Chamber Dollars this Christmas Season!! Last year we sold over \$60,000.00 in Chamber Dollars which means every dollar stays local!!

Tourism did very well in the Chequamegon Bay this year. We were a little anxious with the rainy spring we experienced, but the summer was incredibly strong followed by a very healthy fall season. Winter tourism is shaping up and even though we don't like the extreme cold, we do need it to make ice on the bay for ice fishing and on the water, swampy portions of the snowmobile trails. Winter in the Chequamegon Bay offers something for everyone from cross-country skiing to ice fishing, snowmobiling, tubing and skiing at Mt. Ashwabay, to snowshoeing at the Northern Great Lakes Visitor Center. We are currently running ads in the Duluth, Hibbing, Rochester, Mankato areas for a Winter Weekend Getaway. You can see the commercial on our website. We have a special deal, where we ask people to send us a copy of their receipt after they stay here, and we will enter it in a drawing for \$250.00 in Chamber Dollars to come back at another time! This promotion will run through the end of February.

John McGivern, Around the Corner; Discover Wisconsin, Self-Guided Tours, and Erik the Travel Guy, Beyond your Backyard are all editing their shows for winter/spring airings. We will keep you informed about air dates. This year, we received more earned media than ever. Earned media is when someone writes a story about your destination. We had two stories in Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. One was about the beautiful historic murals and the other was about our quaint, historic, downtown and public art. The Lake Superior Magazine highlighted Ashland several times and featured several events, murals, and our downtown. In addition, the Ashland Area Chamber of Commerce was voted number 1 for Best Customer Service for a business located on Lake Superior. Kudo's to the staff who are always welcoming to our guests!!
