Ashland has been In the News and in the Spotlight!

Recently, John McGivern and Crew from "Around the Corner" on Wisconsin Public Television was here in Ashland producing an episode which highlighted our community. From the Murals to the boat houses, artesian wells, and even Gordy Johnson. They had a great time here and loved our people, our downtown, and the beautiful area. The show will air in March 2020. KBJR channel 6 did a live remote from the Ashland County Fair and a special summer getaway remote which high-lighted ABC Raceway, the Ore dock renovation, Mural Trolley tours, the recent Main Street recognition, and Book Across the Bay.

The Department of tourism chose Ashland as one of five communities to highlight for a story in the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel and it will feature "Shopping local" with an emphasis on small towns that have vibrant downtowns. That story will be in print in October. It will highlight historic murals and community murals, our local ownership of retail, local art, and locally owned restaurants.

Erik the Travel Guy is a show on PBS that will be producing an "Ashland" show and they will be here for four days from September 5th through the 9th filming. They are most excited to film with Andy Pearson making sausage at Sixth Street Market along with the KIYI, the Trolley, and the exquisite architecture found in our historic downtown. Historian Sue Mac-Kenzie-Smith will take them on a fabulous "architec-tour" on Main Street. Show airs in the late spring of 2020.



In October, you'll see Discover Wisconsin shooting the murals for our portion of a show that is dedicated to Self-Guided Tours. That show will air in the spring of 2020.

The fall Trifecta with the Red Clay Classic, Applefest and Memorial Medical Center WhistleStop is right around the corner (no pun intended). These events are a huge economic impact for our area!! Thank you in advance to all of the volunteers that work so hard for all of these events. I'm betting that between the trifecta events, there are close to 1000 volunteers needed!!
